Traci Todora and her 2012 Mustang



I ordered "Donna" (renamed by Jay when we met because, "she's a 'Bad Girl'") in October 2011 and I got her just before Christmas that same year. (Merry Christmas to me!!!!)

She is a 2012 Performance White V6 Premium with Saddle interior and the 6-speed manual transmission. I ordered her for two reasons: 1) because my 2010 didn't like to go into reverse and 2) (most importantly) I was able to finally get the glass roof I wanted.

I have done some modifications to her - the first thing I did was change out the shift knob. I have also changed the taillights (to look more like a 2005-2009) and added a decal over the third taillight that says "Mustang" when I step on the brake. Next came the Nav system with back-up camera. This is really cool as I now have the screen in the car instead of the OEM back-up camera on the rear view mirror. Then, I added a strut tower brace and most recently, I changed out the rims.

The next mod to happen will be an engine chip to boost HP and the last item on my list will be having her striped to look very similar to a 1970 Boss 302. She is the 8th Mustang I have owned over the course of my life and even my Mom has one.

Mustang Trivia

- Currently Mustangs are built at Flat Rock Assembly Plant.
- The all-new 2015 Mustang comes with three engine options – 5.0-liter V8, 3.7-liter V6 and a 2.3-liter EcoBoost engine.
- In 1982, Mustang advertising proclaimed that “The Boss is Back!” with the return of the Mustang 5.0-liter V8.
- More than 9 million Mustangs have been produced and sold year to date.
- The “Fox Body” Mustang platform was on the market the longest in the nameplate’s history, 1979 through 1993.
- Mustang has won Motor Trend’s Car of the Year award twice, the 1974 Mustang II & 1994 Mustang.
- Mustang sold its first 1 million units in 1966.
- When first sold in Germany, the Mustang was badged as the T-5.
- The 1974 Mustang II is the only Mustang not to have a V8 engine option.
- The first generation Mustang chassis was based on the Ford Falcon.
- To celebrate 50 years of continuous production, each 2015 model will celebrate the milestone with a badge on the instrument panel that includes a galloping pony logo and the words “Mustang – Since 1964.”
