



One Mustang Brings People Together for a Cause to Save Veterans

Since purchasing my Mustang this year, I have been having a lot of fun meeting new people at car shows and on social media who have become my "extended Mustang family." One person I recently met is **Bert Trey Baker**. He is using his car to raise awareness for a very important and worthwhile cause. Here is Bert's story.

My car is a ruby red Mustang GT Premium performance pack with a manual transmission. After purchasing the car, a soldier in the Army who served with my wife, ended his battle with PTSD by taking his life. Suicide has been an issue with military members fighting PTSD, as they feel they no longer belong or accepted in society by those who have never experienced such battles. A VA study reported that 22 veterans will take their own lives due to struggling with PTSD. I decided to build my car to create awareness of the Mission 22 directive - to bring the number of suicides down to zero. In doing so, several sponsors have helped me build the car into one that would attract attention and excitement towards Mission 22. Those sponsors include: Xforce, Steeda, Velossatech, Anarchy Motive, JC Customs, Tactical Designs and Hypermotive Performance. Through the support of these sponsors, and through the Mustang Family who buy their products, my car is helping bring an end to veteran suicide, showing that no veteran is alone and we all have someone to talk to. Whether it be in the car community, outdoors, or any other hobbies one may have—I ask that you help me inform others that my brothers and sisters in arms need everyone's help. Let's bring an end to veteran suicides. Join me in this cause to give back to those who have given so much for our freedoms.




